UNLABELED/UNIDENTIFIABLE MATERIALS

WE DO NOT ACCEPT PRESCRIPTION/OVER THE COUNTER DRUGS. PLEASE CALL ISHPEMING CITY, MARQUETTE CITY, NEGAUNEE CITY, CHOCOLAY, OR FORSYTH POLICE DEPARTMENTS, MICHIGAN STATE POLICE, OR MEIJER FOR DROP-OFF TIMES & DAYS.

WHAT TO DO WITH HIMY: TAKE YOUR HIMY TO AN HIMY COLLECTION SITE PLACE THE MATERIALS IN A BOX. IF ANY CONTAINER IS IN POOR CONDITION OR LEAKING, PLACE IN A SEALED CLEAR PLASTIC BAG, MAKE SURE ALL CONTAINERS ARE LABELED. DO NOT MIX CHEMICALS OR TRANSFER CHEMICALS INTO OTHER CONTAINERS. CONTAINERS HOLDING CONTAMNATED GASOLINE WILL NOT BE RETURNED.

ANTIFREEZE, MOTOR OIL, TRANSMISSION OR BRAKE FLUID: PUT EACH IN THEIR OWN CLEAN, DRY CONTAINER (MILK JUG WITH CAP WORKS). SEAL IT WELL AND LABEL IT. CONTAINERS WITH OIL WILL BE EMPTIED AND GIVEN BACK. DO NOT MIX PRODUCTS!

NON-REGULATED HOME MEDICAL WASTE: - INSULIN SYRINGES, IV NEEDLES, LANCETS, ETC. SHOULD BE IN A PUNCTURE-RESISTANT CONTAINER SUCH AS A MILK JUG OR 2-LITER SODA BOTTLE

HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES: PLEASE SEPARATE BATTERIES BY TYPE. TAPE THE ENDS ON 6&9 VOLTS, C'S, D'S, LITHIUM AND WATCH BATTERIES.

<u>COMPOST/ORGANIC MATERIALS</u> COMPOST MUST BE UNDER 2 INCHES IN DIAMETER. NO STUMPS! ORGANIC MATERIALS SUCH AS FOOD WASTE, PLANTS, STRAW, SOILED PAPER TOWELS AND NAPKINS.

# ITEMS CAN NOT BE IN ANY KIND OF PLASTIC BAG OR CONTAINER.

CONFIDENTIAL DOCUMENTS CAN BE BROUGHT IN BY APPOINTMENT 24 HOURS PRIOR TO COMING. IF YOU REQUIRE A CERTIFICATE OF DESTRUCTION THERE IS A \$25.00 CHARGE PAYABLE BY CHECK ONLY. A FORM MUST BE COMPLETED. YOU CAN DOWNLOAD THE FORM ON OUR WEBSITE: WWW.MCSWMA.COM. PLEASE MAKE SURE TO PUT DOCUMENTS IN BANKERS OR COPY PAPER BOXES AND SECURELY TAPE THEM CLOSED.
