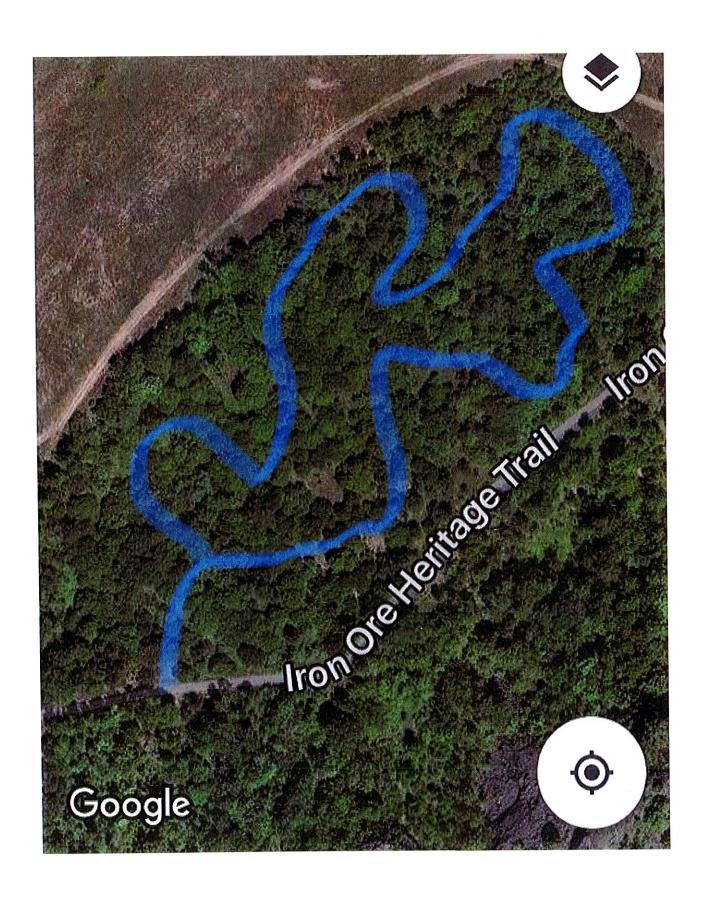

# AGREEMENT FOR THE TRANSFER OF REAL ESTATE

This agreement ("Agreement") is made between The Royal Pub, Inc., 205 E. Division Street, Ishpeming, MI 49849, referred to as "Buyer" and the City of Ishpeming, a Michigan municipal corporation, of 100 E. Division Street, Ishpeming, MI., 49849 as "Seller," as follows:

1. Seller agrees to transfer and Buyer agrees to accept the following described real property located in the City of Ishpeming, County of Marquette, and State of Michigan, and more particularly described as:

201 E. Division Street (Original Plat City of Ishpeming S. 62' of Lot 55 and N.38' of Lot 55)

and

207 E. Division Street (Original Plat City of Ishpeming Lot 57).

subject to the following:

- a. exceptions, reservations, and conditions contained in the instruments constituting the record chain of title to said property;
- b. retained easement
- c. City zoning ordinances and regulations;
- d. terms and conditions set forth in this agreement.

The properties known as 201 East Division Street (including both parcel #52-51-050-055-00 and parcel #52-51-050-055-50) and 207 East Division Street, Ishpeming, Michigan, also identified as parcels #52-51-050-057-00.

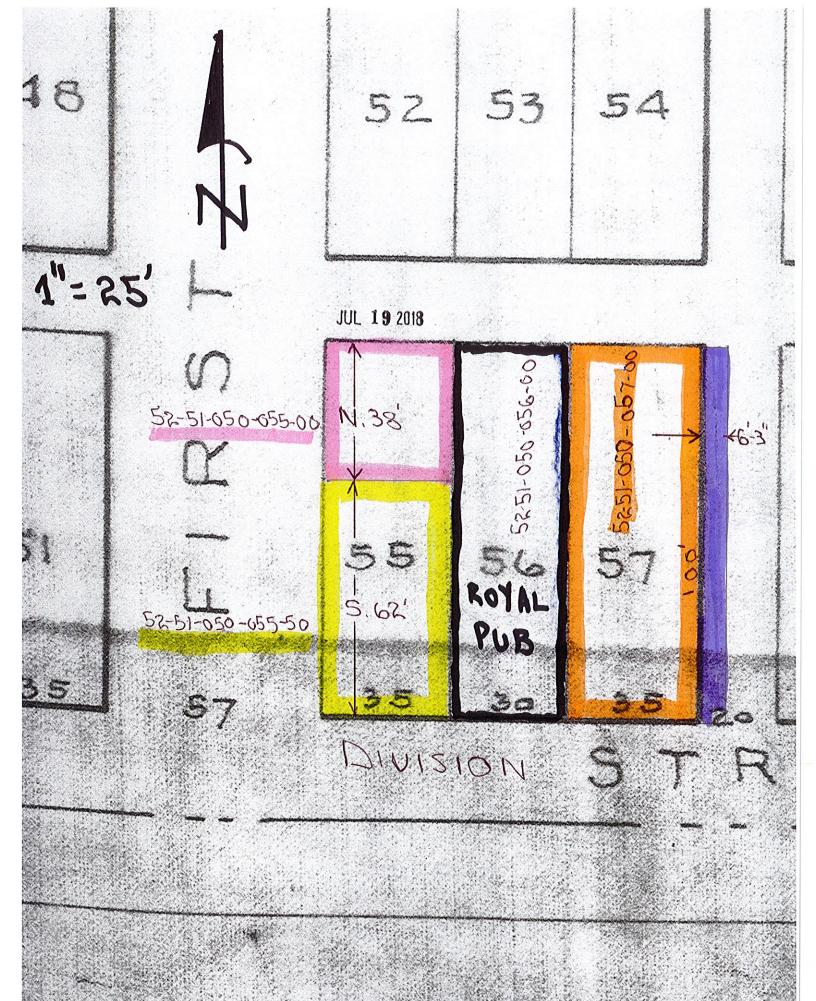
- 2. Consideration: The Buyer will pay to the Seller \$4,000 in cash and also the Buyer agrees to make certain valuable improvements listed below (estimated to be worth about \$8,000) as shown on the attached diagram (Exhibit A) prior to closing. The improvements the Buyer will make shall include the following:
  - a. The Buyer shall install a ten-foot wide grass strip along the entire Southern boundary of each lot (shown in Exhibit A). This grass strip may serve as a snow stock pile area for the mutual benefit of both Seller and Buyer.

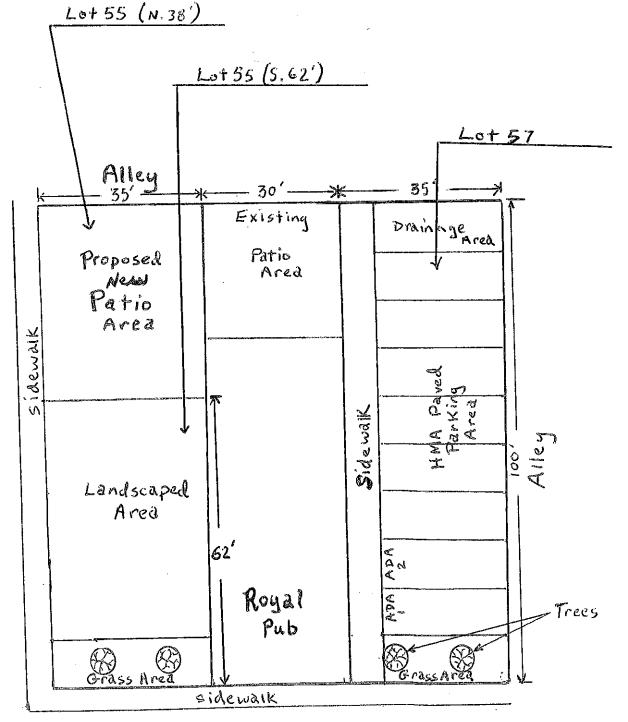
- b. The Buyer shall plant four deciduous trees (two on each side) centered in the grass strip area.
- c. On Lot 55, the Buyer shall install an outdoor patio area (not less than 20 feet by 30 feet) to be constructed of brick pavers or concrete (as shown in Exhibit A).
- d. Said patio is to be furnished with patio tables and chairs purchased by the Buyer (which will be stored indoors at the Buyer's expense during winter months).
- e. Install a three-foot tall decorative fence (not chain link) around the edge of the patio with at least one gate for pedestrian access.
- f. Install decorative landscaping (grass, shrubs, and/or flowers) per Exhibit A.
- g. Install a Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) paved parking lot in Lot 57 including two ADA accessible parking spaces.
- h. Install parking lot drainage per specification of the Seller
- i. Install exterior lighting to illuminate the entire premises. Lighting will be shaded to prevent direct illumination outside of the premises.

As a condition precedent to closing, the Buyer shall complete all improvements, and in no event shall improvements be completed later than October 30, 2021.

- 3. Buyer further agrees to maintain all improvements in a serviceable and attractive condition, including landscaping, and agrees to assume responsibility for the mowing and watering of grass and trees on the premises at owner's expense.
- 4. Buyer agrees to make all the improvements listed above before October 30, 2021.
- 5. "Closing" or "Closes" or "Close" as used herein shall mean the time and date for delivery of the Quit Claim deed by Seller to Buyer which date shall occur on or before October 30, 2021. Should closing not occur on or before October 30, 2021, then this agreement is null and void and neither party shall have any further obligations under this Agreement.
- 6. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and all prior oral or written agreements, promises, and discussions between the parties concerning the Premises are merged into this Agreement. This Agreement may not be modified or amended unless by a separate written instrument signed by both parties.
- 7. This Agreement shall be applied, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Michigan. Venue for any disputes under this Agreement shall lie in Marquette County, Michigan.

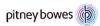

#### ORDINANCE NO. 2-700

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF INOPERABLE MOTOR VEHICLES AND THE USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES FOR STORAGE PURPOSES

THE CITY OF ISHPEMING ORDAINS:

Section 2-701. Definitions. As used herein, the following terms shall be defined as follows:

- a. Motor Vehicle. "Motor vehicle" means every vehicle which is self-propelled.
- b. Vehicle. "Vehicle" means every device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn on a highway, except devices which are moved exclusively by human power or which are used exclusively on stationary rails or tracks and except for a mobile home as defined in Section 2 of Act No. 419 of the Public Acts of 1976, being MCL 125.1101 et. seq.; M.S.A. 19.855(1) et. seq.
- c. <u>Inoperable Motor Vehicle</u>. Every motor vehicle which does not satisfy all of the following requirements shall be considered an inoperable motor vehicle:
  - i) The vehicle is in operating condition and can be operated under its own power; and
  - The vehicle satisfies all requirements of the Michigan Motor Vehicle Code, being Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, as amended (MCLA §257.1 et. seq.), including but not limited to having current registration plates, and meeting all requirements for headlights, tail lights, and all other equipment required for operation on a public highway; and
  - iii) The vehicle is currently insured for comprehensive coverage, at a minimum.
- d. <u>Landowner</u>. "Landowner" means the person, firm, corporation, or entity that is the record legal title owner of the parcel of land upon which an inoperable motor vehicle is kept, stored, placed, or found.

Section 2-702. No landowner shall permit or suffer any inoperable motor vehicle to be parked, stored, kept, maintained, or left on any parcel of land in the City of Ishpeming, except as provided in Section 2-703 hereof. No owner of a motor vehicle shall park, store, keep, maintain or leave an inoperable motor vehicle on any parcel of land in the City of Ishpeming, except as provided in Section 2-703 hereof.

<u>Section 2-703</u>. Inoperable motor vehicles may be stored, parked, kept, maintained, or left only as follows:

- a. In a fully enclosed building;
- b. By a licensed junk or scrap dealer, and then only in accordance with applicable statutes, ordinances and regulations, and then only if such use is permitted under the City Zoning Ordinance;

- c. By State licensed service stations or State licensed auto repair businesses and then only if such use is permitted under the City Zoning Ordinance;
- d. By any governmental agency;
- e. Under a permit issued by the City Council in accordance with the terms of Section 2-704 hereof.

Section 2-704. Upon written application, the City Council may issue a permit, for a period of time not to exceed six (6) months, allowing outdoor storage of an inoperable motor vehicle for any of the following reasons:

- a. Storage of any historic or classic vehicle;
- b. Any vehicle in the process of restoration or repair;

Section 2-704705. The storage, parking or keeping of any inoperable motor vehicle which shall continue for a period of ten (10) days after service of notice of violation of this ordinance is hereby declared to be a public nuisance. Such nuisance shall be abated, and the Police Department shall have the same authority to impound and dispose of inoperable motor vehicles prohibited herein as provided for vehicles abandoned in the public streets or on private property under M.C.L.A. Section 257.252a, et. seq.

Section 2-705706. Notices of violation of this ordinance shall be in writing, shall describe the inoperable motor vehicle and its location, and shall be served upon the landowner or upon the owner of the vehicle, or both, by first class mail sent to their last known addresses.

Section 2-706707. Any landowner who shall allow, permit, or suffer another person to continue to store or keep on his property an inoperable motor vehicle in violation of the terms of this ordinance more than ten (10) days after service of notice of violation of this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor. Every owner of an inoperable motor vehicle who shall allow the vehicle to be parked, stored, kept, or maintained in violation of the terms of this ordinance more than ten (10) days after service of notice of violation of this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Any landowner who shall allow or permit another person to continue to store or keep on his or her property an inoperable motor vehicle in violation of the terms of this ordinance more than ten (10) days after service of notice of violation of this ordinance is responsible for a municipal civil infraction and shall be subject to payment of a civil fine as provided in the City's Annual Fee Schedule.

Every owner of an inoperable motor vehicle who shall allow the vehicle to be parked, stored, kept or maintained in violation of the terms of this ordinance more than ten (10) days after service of notice of violation of this ordinance is responsible for a municipal civil infraction and shall be subject to payment of a civil fine as provided in the City's Annual Fee Schedule.

Section 2-707708. It shall be unlawful for any landowner to permit or suffer any motor vehicle, with or without wheels on it, to be parked, kept or maintained on any parcel of land in the City of Ishpeming for the purpose of using said vehicle for

the storage of garbage, trash, refuse, wood, junk, furniture, appliances, clothing, metal, synthetic materials, goods, wares, books, records, papers, or any other personal property of any kind; provided, however, that this section shall not apply to any vehicle which is regularly used on a weekly basis for the transportation of goods, wares, or merchandise, or for the removal of garbage, trash, refuse or junk to a disposal area.

Section 2-708709. Any landowner or motor vehicle owner who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the Marquette County Jail for a period not to exceed 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Any landowner or motor vehicle owner who violates this ordinance shall be responsible for a municipal civil infraction and shall be subject to payment of a civil fine as provided in the Annual Fee Schedule.

- 1) First violation. Any person who admits responsibility for, or who is found responsible for, a violation of Section 2-706 shall be subject to a civil fine as set forth in the Annual Fee Schedule adopted by the City Council.
- 2) Second violation. Any person who admits responsibility for, or who is found responsible for, a second violation of Section 2-706 shall be subject to a civil fine as set forth in the Annual Fee Schedule adopted by the City Council.

Section 2-710. This ordinance shall take effect upon legal publication.

Re: Audit Services Agreement

Hello.

Attached you will find a proposal from Anderson, Tackman, and Company (ATCO) for audit services for the years ended 2018, 2019 and 2020. There are also two option years available for 2021 and 2022. In my discussions with ATCO, they initially proposed a 5% increase in the audit fee, which is the increase they are presenting to clients across the board. I explained that 5% is beyond an inflationary increase, and I would have to recommend going out for bid unless we could come to a more reasonable fee. In the end, after some negotiation, ATCO agreed to a 3% increase, which is more in line with what the city has been historically charged and is more in line with inflation. As in the past, the fees presented are a "base bid" and additional fees may be charged based on the new accounting pronouncements, whether a federal compliance audit must be performed, or level of cooperation from staff, etc. Please keep in mind that there are indirect costs associated with changing auditors whereby it places additional work on staff to "train in" new auditors.

If council approves this agreement, then we will schedule the preliminary 2018 audit work for December. If council chooses to pass on this agreement and bid out the services, then that will most likely push back our normal audit timeline a bit.

I will not be present at the October 3, 2018 council meeting as I'm leaving town that day to attend the MERS Annual Conference, but please feel free to contact me prior to Wednesday should you have any questions. I asked Mike Grentz of ATCO to be present for the meeting, but he will also be out of town and not able to attend the meeting.

#### Recommendation:

I recommend waiving competitive bidding in the best interest of the city and approving the proposed audit services agreement with Anderson, Tackman, & Company, PLC.
