MICHIGAN MUNICIPAL LEAGUE – INFORMATION GATHERING SESSION - CITY MANAGER POSITION
Jerry Richards, Executive Recruiter with the Michigan Municipal League, summarized the process of hiring a new city manager and reviewed the proposed timeline.

Council provided input to Mr. Richards regarding City government; education and experience preferred, including skills and personality; challenges and opportunities associated with the position; and the community profile which including special events in the City and what the City had to offer.

Mr. Richards advised the ad for the position would be posted by September 6th and run for approximately 4 weeks. The applications would be due on October 4th. He would talk to the proposed applicants, check references, and write a report to present to Council at a meeting and Council would decide who to set up interviews with. It was the consensus of Council to hold this special meeting on October 23, 2019 at 4:00 p.m.

It was the consensus of Council to hold the interviews at a special meeting on Friday, November 8, 2019 beginning at 8:30 a.m.
