

The Special Meeting of the Ishpeming City Council was held on Monday, December 23, 2019, in the Ishpeming City Hall Council Chambers. Mayor Mike Tonkin called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m.

Present: Mayor Mike Tonkin, Councilmembers, Lindsay Bean, Jason Chapman, and Pat Scanlon (4).

Absent: Councilmember Stuart Skauge (1). Also present was Interim City Manager Steven Snowaert. City Attorney Bonnie Hoff was absent.

AGENDA COMMENT – There was none.

LAKE BANCROFT PAVILION – PAY APPLICATION #7, GE BUILDERS

Brian Fabbri, GEI Consultants, reviewed the pay application and advised the project retainer was also reduced from 10% to 3% for the project.

A motion was made by Councilmember Scanlon, supported by Councilmember Bean and carried unanimously to approve pay application #7 for GE Builders for the Lake Bancroft Pavilion project as presented.

REPAIRS TO THE 1999 PETERBILT PLOW REPAIRS BY CROSSROADS TRUCK REPAIR

A motion was made by Councilmember Scanlon, supported by Councilmember Chapman and carried unanimously to authorize repairs to the 1999 Peterbilt Plow at Crossroads Truck Repairs in the amount of \$5,743 and waive competitive bidding on the recommendation of the City Manager.

TENTATIVE AGREEMENT WITH DPW, SUPERVISORY, AND CLERICAL CHAPTERS OF LOCAL 1282 AFSCME UNION

Interim City Manager Snowaert reviewed the tentative agreement which was for one year with the contract expiring December 31, 2020.

A motion was made by Councilmember Scanlon, supported by Councilmember Chapman and carried unanimously to approve the Tentative Agreement and authorize city staff to move forward with the AFSCME units.

Council was glad the contract negotiations were settled and thanked the union and the negotiating teams for all their work. The agreement was good for both parties.
