Dear City of Ishpeming Council Members

UP Engineers & Architects was contracted by the City of Ishpeming to complete the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWRF) Project Plan for potential funding through the State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program. The Project Plan was specific to the 2023 construction items identified by UPEA and City Staff for improvements to the City of Ishpeming Sewer System. This work includes 45,000 feet of VCP sewer main, SCADA and generator improvements and lift stations, and the relocation of existing sewer main with the proposed lift station installation. These improvements are needed to improve the operational capabilities and emergency reliability of the system. The current project cost estimate is at \$16,050,000. It is projected that this project size, with a term of 30 years and a rate of 2.125%, would result in a rate increase of approximately \$30 per residential user. It is worth noting that this assumes zero dollars in principal forgiveness/grant or the use of any current annual reserves that the City collects on the City of Ishpeming Sewer System.

If EGLE makes a funding offer to the City of Ishpeming for the proposed project, an analysis will be performed by UPEA to determine if that is the most cost-effective funding option. The approval of this project plan and the adoption of the attached resolution moves the application process forward with the State of Michigan but does not require the City to accept a funding offer. There is a good chance that USDA RD will still have more attractive rates/terms/grant percentages for the City of Ishpeming Sewer System. UPEA will be evaluating all options once a funding offer is made and bringing that information back to the City Council for review/discussion/approval.

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A FINAL PROJECT PLAN FOR WASTEWATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS AND DESIGNATING AN AUTHORIZED PROJECT REPRESENTATIVE

WHEREAS, the <u>City of Ishpeming</u> recognizes the need to make improvements to its existing wastewater treatment and collection system; and

WHEREAS, the <u>City of Ishpeming</u> authorized <u>UP Engineers & Architects, Inc.</u> to prepare a Project Plan, which recommends the construction of <u>45,000 feet of VCP sewer main</u>, <u>SCADA and generator improvements at lift stations</u>, and the relocation of existing sewer main in association with the proposed lift station installation; and

WHEREAS, said Project Plan was presented at a Public Hearing held on <u>May 25, 2022</u> and all public comments have been considered and addressed;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the <u>City of Ishpeming</u> formally adopts said Project Plan and agrees to implement the selected alternative (Alternative No. 1).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the <u>City Manager</u>, a position currently held by <u>Craig Cugini</u>, is designated as the authorized representative for all activities associated with the project referenced above, including the submittal of said Project Plan as the first step in applying to the State of Michigan for a revolving fund loan to assist in the implementation of the selected alternative.
