The Special meeting of the Ishpeming City Council was held on Wednesday, May 25, 2022, in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Mayor Lindsay Bean called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

There was no public comment. Mayor Lindsay Bean closed the Public Hearing at 6:11 p.m.


RESOLUTION #7-2022, APPROVING THE CLEAN WATER REVOLVING FUND PROJECT PLAN-
