

*Ishpeming City Council Special Proceedings: November 12, 2025*

1. CALL TO ORDER

The Special meeting of the Ishpeming City Council was held on Wednesday, November 12, 2025, in the Ishpeming City Hall Council Chambers. Mayor Pat Scanlon called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Present: Mayor Pat Scanlon, Council Members Ben Argall, Brett Argall, and Kurt Kipling (4). Absent: Councilmember Jason Chapman (1). Also, present was City Manager Randy Scholz and City Attorney Caroline Bridges.

3. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

A motion was made by Councilmember Ben Argall, seconded by Councilmember Brett Argall, and carried unanimously to approve the agenda as presented.

4. PUBLIC COMMENT – There was none.

5. ITEMS OF BUSINESS

a. Anderson Tackman and Company: 2024 Audit Presentation

Mike Greutz, Anderson Tackman and Company, presented the 2024 City Audit. He reviewed the net position of the City and added it was a good audit. He further reviewed the MERS pension and the Act 345 Police Fire Pension; discussed the large amount of infrastructure funds the city received; and noted the Brasswire Campground Fund and the Motor Pool Fund would be included in the General Fund moving forward.

b. 2026 Budget Discussion

Finance Director/Deputy Manager Grey Getschow reviewed the Capital Improvement Plan overview and briefly discussed the Brasswire Campground solar lighting project. He also noted the DDA may have a couple recommended changes at their next regular meeting, but any changes would be covered under their budget.

Staff and Council briefly discussed the Capital Improvement Projects for 2026.

c. Confirm reappointment of Cathy Miron to a 3-year term on the Commission on Aging: Term Exp 9/2028

A motion was made by Councilmember Brett Argall, seconded by Councilmember Kurt Kipling, and carried unanimously to reappoint Cathy Miron to a 3-year term on the Commission on Aging with her term expiring 9/2028.
