ORDINANCE NO. 3-800

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARADES, PROCESSIONS AND OPEN AIR PUBLIC MEETINGS IN THE CITY OF ISHPEMING, MICHIGAN

THE CITY OF ISHPEMING ORDAINS:

Section 3-801. No parade, procession or open air public meeting shall be allowed upon any street, alley or public way in the City of Ishpeming, nor shall any open air public meeting be held upon any lands or premises abutting upon any street, alley or public way in the City of Ishpeming, unless and until a permit in writing therefor shall be first obtained from the City Manager. Application to conduct or hold such parade, procession or open air public meeting shall be made in writing to the Chief of Police and filed with the City Clerk by the person or persons in charge or control thereof or responsible therefor. Such application shall set forth the route along which such parade or procession is to proceed, the time of starting and the name or names of the person, persons, corporation, society or association in control thereof or responsible therefor, and the purpose of such parade or procession. And in case of an open air public meeting the applicant shall specify the place at which it is desired to hold such meeting, the purpose thereof and the name of the person, persons, corporation, society or association in control thereof or responsible therefor, the time at which such meeting is to be held and the probable duration thereof. Upon any such application being made and filed as above provided, the Chief of Police, under the direction of the City Manager, shall investigate or cause to be investigated the person, persons, corporation, society or association making such application, and the truth of the statements made in such application, regarding the purpose or object of such parade, procession or open air public meeting. And if it shall be found upon such investigation that such contemplated parade, procession or open public meeting is not unlawful and will not in any way or manner tend to a breach of the peace, unnecessarily interfere with the public use of the streets, alleys and public ways of the City, or the peace and quiet of the inhabitants thereof, the City Manager shall issue a permit to the person, persons, corporation, association or society making application therefor without fee or charge.

<u>Section 3-802</u>. Any person, persons, corporation, society or association violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of not less than ten (\$10.00) dollars nor more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars, together with costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine, shall be imprisoned in the City Jail of the City of Ishpeming or the County Jail of Marquette County for a term of not to exceed ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

<u>Section 3-803</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances relating to the same subject matter and contravening the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3-804. This ordinance shall take effect upon legal publication.
