

ORDINANCE NO. 3-1000

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE SALE OF FOOD, GOODS, WARES, MERCHANDISE  
AND SERVICES IN AND UPON MAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF ISHPEMING

THE CITY OF ISHPEMING ORDAINS:

Section 3-1001. This ordinance shall only apply to the sale of food, goods, wares, merchandise, or services in and upon Main Street, between Division Street and Cleveland Avenue, in the City of Ishpeming.

Section 3-1002. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to sell or offer for sale any food, goods, wares, merchandise, or services in or upon Main Street, between Division Street and Cleveland Avenue, or on the sidewalks adjacent thereto, from any booth, stall, tent, table, vehicle, or otherwise, unless Main Street has been closed to vehicular traffic by order of the Ishpeming City Council or by the Ishpeming Chief of Police.

Section 3-1003. When the Ishpeming City Council or the Chief of Police has issued an order to close Main Street, between Division Street and Cleveland Avenue, in connection with any bazaar, street fair, or other event where the issuing authority authorizes the sale of food, goods, wares, merchandise or services, any person, firm, or corporation that wishes to participate in such sales may do so; provided, however, that no vendor or seller may engage in the sale or display of any food, goods, wares, merchandise, or services on that portion of Main Street, or on the sidewalk adjacent thereto, in front of a store owned or occupied by another person, unless the owner or occupant of the store has given written permission to the vendor or seller to do so; provided further, however, that any person, firm, or corporation that does engage in such sales may be asked for proper identification by the Ishpeming Police Department, and any vendor who fails or refuses to provide proper identification may be summarily ejected by the Ishpeming Police Department from the area where Main Street is closed.

Section 3-1004. A vendor or seller who violates the provisions of Section 3-1003 above may be relocated, or may be summarily ejected from the area where Main Street is closed, at the discretion of the Ishpeming Police Department.

Section 3-1005. Any person, firm, or corporation conducting any activity contrary to the terms of this ordinance, or in a manner likely to cause harm or injury to any person, may be summarily ejected from the area closed to vehicular traffic by the Ishpeming Police Department, and in addition thereto may be subject to such other sanctions that may be legally imposed.

Section 3-1006. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance is guilty of a municipal civil infraction, punishable by a civil fine not to exceed \$100.00, plus costs.

Adopted: June 19, 2002, as an emergency ordinance, effective immediately.
