ORDINANCE NO. 9-100

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE FURNISHING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO MINORS AND PROHIBITING FALSIFICATION OF IDENTITY TO OBTAIN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

THE CITY OF ISHPEMING ORDAINS:

<u>Section 9-101</u>. <u>Purchase</u>. No person shall willfully sell, give, purchase for the use by, or furnish any alcoholic beverage to a minor under the age of 21 years except upon authority of and pursuant to a prescription of a duly licensed physician.

<u>Section 9-102</u>. <u>False Representation</u>. No person under the age of 21 years shall, by documentary evidence, falsely represent himself to be 21 years of age or over for the purpose of purchasing, or attempting to purchase any alcoholic liquor, nor shall any person give any such false information regarding his age to any person selling alcoholic liquor for the purpose of securing the sale thereof to himself or to any other person under the age of 21 years; nor shall any person furnish substitute documentary evidence to any person under 21 years of age, to be used by any such person for the purpose of obtaining alcoholic liquor.

Section 9-103. Penalty. Violations of this ordinance shall be punishable by the following schedule of fines and imprisonment:

First offense - a fine not to exceed \$100.00 or imprisonment in the Marquette County Jail for a period not to exceed 30 days, or both.

Second offense - a fine not to exceed \$100.00 or imprisonment in the Marquette County Jail for a period not to exceed 60 days, or both.

Third and subsequent offenses - a fine not to exceed \$100.00 or imprisonment in the Marquette County Jail for a period not to exceed \$0 days, or both.
