

The Special Meeting of the Ishpeming City Council was held on Wednesday, September 20, 2017 in the Ishpeming City Hall Conference Room. Mayor Joseph Juidici called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Present: Mayor Joseph Juidici, Council Members Justin Koski (arrived 10:06 a.m.), Karl Lehmann, Stuart Skauge, and Mike Tonkin (5). Also present was City Manager Mark Slown and Attorney Bonnie Hoff.

AGENDA COMMENT – There was none.

PUBLIC HEARING FOR POSSIBLE VACATION OF A PORTION OF INDUSTRIAL WAY

Mayor Juidici opened the public hearing at 10:02 a.m.

Brett French, UPPCO, advised they had purchased the property on the corner of Greenwood Street and Washington Street and discussed their development plans if the Industrial Way vacation was approved.

Jon Kangas explained the City would retain an easement for the water and sewer utilities on the vacated site. He had also received some concerns from Applied Science who owns the building to the west of the proposed vacation regarding access to their property; but after discussions it was felt the issues could be worked out regarding access and snowplowing.

Mayor Juidici closed the public hearing at 10:10 a.m.

ADOPT RESOLUTION #2017-12, SUPPORT FOR JASPERLITE SENIOR HOUSING PROJECT

Amy Lerlie, Community Action Alger-Marquette, advised the MSHDA grant application was being resubmitted for the Jasperlite Senior Housing Project and they were requesting an updated resolution of support from the City for this project.

A motion was made by Councilman Koski, supported by Councilman Lehmann and carried unanimously to adopt resolution #2107-12 supporting the Jasperlite Senior Housing project.

MILLER CANFIELD FEE – 2017 GENERAL OBLIGATION UNLIMITED TAX BONDS

A motion was made by Councilman Lehmann, supported by Councilman Koski and carried unanimously to approve the fee from Miller Canfield in the amount of \$10,000 for the 2017 General Obligation Unlimited Tax Bonds.
