The Marquette County Solid Waste Management Authority has received a Scrap Tire Cleanup Grant from the MDEQ. All Marquette County residents are welcome to bring their scrap tires to the following collections. **Residents may bring in up to 10 tires at a time. Car and truck tires that are 22.5 inches in diameter or less will be accepted at these collections. Tires on rims will be accepted. Larger tires, tractor tires and tires on split rims will not be accepted at these sites.
